BOX 90 NIDDRIE 3042. **Please make cheques/money orders payable to Calibre Sports Inc.** A photo ID will be issued upon payment of membership fee, this card **MUST** be worn at all times whilst on an approved shooting range. "CALIBRE SPORTS INC" membership fees includes member insurance. Unlicenced members will not be permitted to use any handguns unless under direct supervision of a person who is the holder of a current handgun licence. All members must comply with club rules and regulations.

Police approved Handgun Safety Awareness Courses are conducted on a regular basis and you must book and pay in advance to secure a place. The theory component of the course covers safety & legal issues and the practical component includes a series of live fire exercises. You will be required to sign the statutory declaration provided by the club to say that you are not a prohibited person, this must be done prior to anyone handling any firearms. Calibre Sports requires all members to complete a Handgun Safety Awareness Course prior to applying for a Probationary Permit To Use Handguns. At the completion of the course, you will receive the Certificate required to apply for your handgun Licence, and all the necessary information about the Calibre Sports Inc Pistol Club. (You must have been a member of an approved pistol club for a minimum of 6 months, participated in the required number of shoots (5) and have completed a Handgun Safety Awareness Course when you apply for your licence) This certificate is valid for 6 or 9 months. You must apply for your handgun licence within this time.

"CALIBRE SPORTS" holds regular competitions. The competitions are open to anyone who holds a General Handgun Licence (endorsed for sport & target shooting).

- (t) a principal in the teaching service;
- (u) the manager of a bank;
- (v) a member of the Institute of Chartered Accountants in Australia or the Australian Society of Accountants or the National Institute of Accountants;
- (w) the secretary of a building society;
- (x) a minister of religion authorised to celebrate marriages;
- (y) a person employed under Part 3 of the **Public Sector Management and Employment Act 1998** with a classification that is prescribed as a classification to which this section applies or who holds office in a statutory authority with such a classification;
